Hello,

I am writing to support the creation of stronger pollution control in New Mexico. It is critical to target oil and natural gas equipment that emit volatile organic compounds (VOCs) and oxides of nitrogen (NOx). These gases are precursors to the formation of ozone, a very unhealthy gas to breath. Regulating these emissions will also reduce emissions of methane, a potent greenhouse gas.

In addition, the pollution from oil and natural gas equipment is particularly high in the NM northeast region where the Navajo Nation is located. These Natives, who suffer from a number of conditions that reduce their health, do not need elevated pollution.

Please put regulations in place which will ultimately mean cleaner air and a healthier environment for Natives and all New Mexicans.
