**ORDER MODIFYING SCHEDULING ORDER**

On July 10, 2014, a Scheduling Order was filed in this matter, signed by Chair and Hearing Officer Butch Tongate. The Order set the Triennial Review hearing to begin on April 14, 2015 and a Pre-Hearing Conference was set for April 7, 2015. On January 13, 2015, the Water Quality Control Commission vacated the setting for the Triennial Review hearing and instructed the undersigned Hearing Officer to re-schedule the Triennial Review hearing to be held in May or June of 2015. On January 27, 2015, the New Mexico Environment Department filed an unopposed motion seeking clarification of scheduling for the Triennial Review hearing.

Pursuant to the Commission's instructions, and the July 10, 2014 Order, the undersigned Hearing Officer orders the following:

1. The Triennial Review hearing shall begin on June 9, 2015 and continue from day to day as necessary to hear from all parties and the public. Pursuant to Section 302A of the Procedural Order, public notice of the hearing shall be given at least (60) days prior to the hearing.
2. The Hearing Officer shall entertain all outstanding motions and other pre-hearing issues during a Pre-Hearing Conference on April 14, 2015 beginning at 1:30 p.m.
3. All other pre-Triennial Review hearing deadlines, as established in the July 10, 2014 Order, remain in effect.

4. All post-Triennial Review hearing deadlines, as established in the July 10, 2014 Order, remain in effect.

This Order should be read in conjunction with the Procedural Order published July 10, 2014.


