NO _x Emission Reductions					
Under this criterion, one point will be awarded per 200 pounds NO _x reduced per project with a maximum of 200 points.	Tons reduced for total project, one point per 200 pounds NO _x up to 40,000 pounds (200 tons)	200		0	
Cost Effectiveness					
Under this criterion there will be a maximum of 150 points awarded. Cost Effectiveness is the dollars per pound for NO _x reductions for the entire project. The fewer dollars per ton the more cost effective the project is. Points will be awarded on an incremental scale as shown. An additional 50 points may be added based on the summary provided in this category. The applicant must provide a detailed summary discussing the means for calculating cost effectiveness using the required calculation tools. 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Cost Share					
Under this criterion there will be a maximum of 100 points awarded. Cost share is based on the percent of funding the applicant is proposing to contribute to the project. One point will be awarded for each percentage of the cost contributed by the applicant. (e.g., An applicant contributing 15% to the project will be awarded 15 points; an applicant contributing 50% will get 50 points; and an applicant requesting 100% funding will not be awarded any points.) Sensitive Populations					
Under this criterion there will be a maximum of 250 points awarded. Up to 75 points per percent minority levels and up to 75 points per percent poverty level in the affected project area. Projects affecting selected sensitive populations (schools, hospitals, other medical facilities, elderly) may receive a further 25-50 points. An additional 50 discretionary points may be awarded based on the summary provided in the application. The applicant must provide a detailed summary discussing the project area impacts on the disproportionately affected residents and the source of the data used in this category. 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National Ambient Air Quality Standards Status					
<p>Under this criterion, a maximum of 250 points may be awarded. 200 points for any project that is located within an area that is considered to be non-attainment for ozone; a maximum of 100 points for any project that is located in a county that shows monitoring data leading to design values greater than or equal to 95% of the ozone NAAQS but not designated by EPA as nonattainment. An additional 50 discretionary points may be awarded based on the summary provided in the NAAQS category. The applicant must provide a detailed summary the project area and the NAAQS. The applicant must provide a detailed summary of the proximity of the selected criteria and impacts in the project area from the selections outlined in the criteria category.
