THE NEW MEXICO ENVIRONMENT DEPARTMENT'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION FOR FILING FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

COMES NOW the Respondent, New Mexico Environment Department ("NMED"), and requests a delay of two days in filing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in the above-captioned matter. In support of this motion, Respondent offers the following:

- 1. The appointed Hearing Officer in this matter filed an Amended Deadline for Submission of Finding of Fact and Conclusions of Law on August 11, 2017, specifying that the deadline for filing such documents is August 21, 2017.
- 2. To aid the Commission in its deliberations, Petitioner United Nuclear Corporation and Respondent NMED plan to file a Joint Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.
- 3. A deadline of August 23, 2017, will ensure that Petitioner and Respondent can work out all necessary details in order to file a joint document.
- 4. Petitioner and Counsel for Laguna Pueblo do not oppose this motion. A voicemail was left for the Multicultural Alliance for a Safe Environment ("MASE"), but no position could be obtained by the time of the filing of the motion.

WHEREFORE Respondent respectfully requests that the deadline for filing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in the above-captioned case be extended until Wednesday, August 23, 2017.
