ORDER FOR HEARING AND APPOINTMENT OF HEARING OFFICER

The New Mexico Water Quality Control Commission (“Commission”), through its duly appointed Chairperson, hereby orders that the Petition by the New Mexico Environment Department, Surface Water Quality Bureau (“Bureau”), as referenced above, be set for public hearing pursuant to the Water Quality Act, NMSA 1978, Sections 74-6-1 to -17 (1967, as amended through 2013), and the Commission’s Rulemaking Procedures at 20.1.6 NMAC (“Rulemaking Procedures”). The hearing shall commence on January 9, 2018, and continue until completion or as may be ordered.

The Commission designates Erin Anderson as the Commission’s Hearing Officer for the hearing. The Hearing Officer is hereby granted all authority and power of the Commission as provided in the Rulemaking Procedures at 20.1.6.100 NMAC, or as may be otherwise provided by law.
