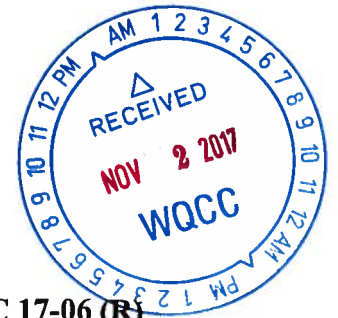

REVISED SCHEDULING ORDER


On the 20th day of October 2017, the Chair of the Water Quality Control Commission (“Commission”) designated Erin O. Anderson, Administrative Law Judge for the New Mexico Environment Department, to schedule the public hearing before the Commission and serve as Hearing Officer. The hearing will be conducted in accordance with the New Mexico Water Quality Act and the Rulemaking Procedures for the Water Quality Control Commission, 20.1.6 NMAC. Accordingly, the Hearing Officer issues the following Scheduling Order.

The public hearing will be held during the Commission’s scheduled meeting on **Tuesday, January 9, 2018, at 9:00 a.m.** at Mabry Hall, in the Jerry Apodaca Education Building, 300 Don Gaspar Avenue, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87501.

Notice of Intent to file technical testimony shall be filed no later than December 20, 2017.

Any other documents or exhibits filed shall consist of an original and 12 copies and be filed with the Commission Administrator, Pam Casteñeda, at least 14 days prior to the hearing.
