**NEW MEXICO ENVIRONMENT DEPARTMENT'S
MOTION FOR RECORDING OF RULEMAKING HEARING**

COMES NOW the New Mexico Environment Department (“NMED” or “Department”) and moves the Hearing Officer that the proceedings in the hearing in the above captioned matter, scheduled for August 14, 2018, be electronically recorded rather than transcribed by a court reporter. As grounds for this motion, NMED states as follows:

1. Pursuant to 20.1.6.303.A NMAC, each rulemaking hearing requires that a transcript be made of the hearing unless otherwise specified by the Hearing Officer.
2. NMED anticipates that the hearing scheduled in this matter will last less than the two hours currently scheduled. Further, NMED has received no comments or expressions of interest from the public regarding this rulemaking, nor have any notices of intent to present technical testimony been filed in this matter, apart from NMED’s.
3. NMED anticipates that a recording of the hearing scheduled for August 14, 2018, will adequately serve as record keeping purposes without adding unnecessary cost to the proceedings.

WHEREFORE, the Department respectfully requests that this motion be granted and that the Hearing Officer allow an electronic recording of the proceedings and not require a transcript.
