ORDER GRANTING STIPULATED MOTION

This matter comes before the Hearing Officer on the Stipulated Motion by all parties to the following:

1. That the 90-day deadline in Section 20.1.3.16.B(1) NMAC be waived;
2. That a hearing officer be appointed;
3. That the following briefing schedule be as follows: The Petitioner's brief is due November 19, 2018; the response briefs of Permittees and the Environment Department are due December 31, 2018; and the Petitioner's reply brief is due February 4, 2019.

The Commission having appointed the hearing officer named below, the Stipulated Motion is granted.

The Commission Administrator shall set up a teleconference at a time when all counsel and the hearing officer are available after January 1, 2019 to discuss the timing of the hearing before the Commission. Counsel are advised that during a year with a 60-day legislative session, the Commission does not typically meet in the months of February or March.
