

**NEW MEXICO WATER QUALITY CONTROL COMMISSION ADDITIONAL NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO 2015 NMACE THE MORTGAGE**

The New Mexico Water Quality Control Commission will hold a public hearing beginning at 1:00 p.m. on April 3, 2015 at the Bessie Coleman Branch Regional Museum and Art Center, 300 West 11th Street, Bessie, New Mexico, to consider proposed amendments to the Commission's General and Surface Water Protection Rule, 20.00 NMACE, referred to as the "General Rule" and proposed to WQCC 12-00 (1) by the State of New Mexico and the Clean Environment (DNCE). Any location changes will be posted. The proposed amendments would establish new rules for the ability and ability to specify measures to be taken to prevent water pollution and to monitor water quality.

Notice of intent for the hearing must be received by the Office of the Commission Administrator by 4 p.m. on March 3, 2015 and should include the name of the petitioner, the date of the hearing, and location number WQCC 12-00 (1) and 12-00 (2). Notice of intent to present written testimony must be filed by March 20, 2015. All parties will need a copy of the rule and/or proposed amendments to be filed by March 20, 2015. Written testimony will not be accepted.

Any notices or additional testimony must be filed no later than 5 p.m. on March 27, 2015. Responses to the additional testimony must be filed no later than 4 p.m. on April 3, 2015. Written testimony accepted before the hearing for the proposed amendments must be consistent with the Proceedings Order issued October 9, 2014.

The proposed amendments would establish new rules for the Dairy industry to specify measures to be taken to prevent water pollution and to monitor water quality.

Notices of intent for the hearing must be received by the Office of the Commission Administrator by 5 p.m. on March 6, 2015 and should reference the name of the regulation, the date of the hearing, and docket number WQCC 12-09 (R) and 13-08 (R). Notices of intent to present rebuttal testimony shall be filed by March 20, 2015. All parties that filed a notice of intent on or before October 17, 2014 shall not file another notice of intent and additional rebuttal testimony will not be accepted.

Any motions on evidentiary matters shall be filed no later than 5 p.m. on March 27, 2015. Responses to evidentiary motions shall be filed no later than 5 p.m. on April 3, 2015. Unless specifically modified herein, the hearing for the above-captioned matter will be conducted consistent with the Procedural Order entered October 3, 2014.
