	Roll was taken; it was noted that a quorum was present.
Item 2.	Approval of Agenda.
Action:	Mr. Waters moved approval of the Agenda. Mr. Sloane seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
Item 3.	Approval of minutes of May 8, 2012 meeting.
Action:	Mr. Vigil moved approval of the Minutes. Mr. Dominguez seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
Item 4.	Request for Hearing in WQCC 12-06 (A), Petition for Review of Discharge Permit 11-97 Renewal and Modification, by Legend Dairy, LLC. Randy, Sybrand J. and Jonathan Vander Dussen, Petitioners. Dalva Moellenberg of Gallagher & Kennedy for Petitoners; Misty Braswell, NMED/OGC.
Action:	T. J. Trujillo introduced himself as substituting for Mr. Moellenberg of Gallagher & Kennedy and offered to waive the ninety day time limit in which a hearing must be set in order to allow discussions to continue.
	Mr. Vigil made a motion to waive the ninety day time limit and set the hearing for the October meeting. Mr. Cunniff, the new Counsel to the Commission, asked Mr. Trujillo to submit a letter to the Commission putting in writing the fact that he was waiving the ninety day time limit. Mr. Sloane seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
Item 5.	Request for Hearing in WQCC 12-07 (R), on Proposal to Amend Surface Water Quality Standards for Nichols and McClure Reservoirs, the Santa Fe River, and the Galisteo Watershed. Tim Michael, Deborah Sarabia and James Hogan, NMED/SWQB; Ryan Flynn, NMED/OGC.
Action:	Chris Atencio from NMED/OGC, along with Tim Michael, Deborah Sarabia and James Hogan, requested a hearing at the December meeting and that a Hearing Officer be appointed to prepare a scheduling order.
	Mr. Sloane made a motion to set the hearing at the regular meeting in December and to appoint Ms. Orth as Hearing Officer to prepare a scheduling order. Mr. Waters seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Item 6.	Approval of final draft TMDL Upper Rio Grande Watershed. Heidi Henderson, James Hogan, NMED/SWQB.
Action:	Ms. Henderson made a presentation summarizing the request for approval of nine TMDLs relating to E. coli in the Upper Rio Grande Watershed.
	Mr. Vigil made a motion to approve the final draft for the Upper Rio Grande Watershed. Mr. Glass seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Action:	Mr. Flynn said that no enforcement actions were taken on behalf of the Commission.
