Item #1: Roll Call

Item #4: Motion to Dismiss – In the Matter of the Appeal Petition on Chino Mines Company's Proposed Ground Water Supplemental Discharge Permit for Closure DP – 1340. WQCC 03-14A

After discussion between the Commission, Counsel for Chino Mines Counsel for Grip, and Counsel for the Environment Department, the following action was taken:
