Due to inclement weather conditions the meeting was called to order by Mr. Goldstein at 11:05 a.m. instead of 9:00 a.m.

Item 1. Roll Call:

The Commission administrator took roll and noted a quorum was present.

Item 2. Approval of Agenda

Action: Mr. Glass moved Commission adoption of the Agenda. Mr. Dominguez seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

Item 3. Approval of the meeting minutes of August 11, 2009.

Action: Mr. Glass moved Commission approval of the August 11, 2009 meeting minutes. Mr. Lewis seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

Item 4. Request for hearing on NMED Utility Operator Certification Program and the New Mexico Utility Operator Advisory Board in re: WQCC 09-12 (R) to Amend the Utility Operator Certification Regulations, Sections 20.7.4.13 and 29.7.4.14 NMAC. Jerry Dickinson, NMED/OGC; Glen Saums, NMED/SWOB; Marcie Leavitt, NMED

Mr. Dickinson requested that the Commission set the hearing in this matter on the Commission's April agenda.

Action: Mr. Glass moved that the Commission approve a hearing setting in WQCC 09-12 (R), Utility Operators Certification Program, on the Commission's April 13, 2010 agenda. Mr. Hutchinson seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

Ms. Fox stated that she and Mr. Domenici had discussed possible dates for scheduling the hearings back-to-back. She noted that they would both be available the week of April 26th.
