**SECOND PROCEDURAL ORDER RELATING TO THE  
JOINT MOTION FOR STAY OF 20.6.7 NMAC**

The Parties in this matter participated in a teleconference with the Hearing Officer on December 13, 2013 to discuss the hearing on the Motion for Stay re-scheduled from the Commission's December 10, 2013 meeting. All were agreed to the re-scheduled date of hearing, and it is so ordered:

1. The Commission will hear the Joint Motion for Stay on January 8, 2014.
2. The time allowed for witness presentation and oral legal argument is limited as follows:
  - a. Parties in support of the Motion for Stay have a total of twenty minutes for opening statements, divided as they agree among themselves.
  - b. Parties in opposition of the Motion for Stay have a total of twenty minutes for opening statements, divided as they agree among themselves.
  - c. Each of the witnesses presented may speak on direct examination for ten minutes before standing for cross-examination.
  - d. Parties in support of the Motion for Stay have a total of twenty minutes for closing statements, divided as they agree among themselves.

- e. Parties in opposition of the Motion for Stay have a total of twenty minutes for closing statements, divided as they agree among themselves.
3. The Hearing Officer will accept brief arguments on the Motion to Disqualify the Commission filed December 13, 2013, prior to the anticipated hearing on the Motion for Stay.
