## **Order Extending Discovery Deadlines**

This matter came before me on the motion of Complainant, New Mexico Environment

Department, to extend discovery deadlines by 30 days. In support of its motion, Complainant

cites the Order vacating the hearing scheduled in this matter for June 9, 2020, and rescheduling
the hearing for August 11, 2020. Complainant further cites the Public Health Order issued by
the New Mexico Department of Health on April 30, 2020, and Executive Order 2020-026. Based
on these orders and circumstances, Complainant argues that compliance with the current
discovery deadlines would place its employees in unnecessary danger to their health and
safety. Complainant therefore requests that the discovery deadlines be extended by 30 days to
June 25, 2020.

Respondent does not oppose Complainant's motion.

Having reviewed Complainant's motion and being otherwise fully advised, I find Complainant's motion is well taken. I therefore order that the discovery deadlines for this matter be extended until June 25, 2020.
