## 2020 Calendar Year in Review

## INTRODUCTION

The Construction Programs Bureau (CPB) directly manages three funding sources, Capital Outlay Appropriations (CO), the Clean Water State Revolving Loan Fund Program (CWSRF), and the Rural Infrastructure Program (RIP). CPB engineering staff provide technical oversight for these funding programs as well as for programs funded by the New Mexico Finance Authority for water, wastewater, drainage, watershed restoration and solid waste projects. Over \$32.5 million was disbursed from the directly managed programs and over \$36.9 million was disbursed from the NMFA programs in calendar year 2020.

CPB strives to ensure projects are sustainable, environmentally sound, completed on a timely basis, and free of waste, fraud, and abuse.



# PROJECT MANAGER SERVICE AREA MAP











# CLEAN WATER STATE REVOLVING FUND

The Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) provides low interest rate loans ranging from 0 to 1.0% for terms of up to 30 years. In September of 2020 the Water Quality Control Commission approved the new lower interest rates for the CWSRF program and the amended priority ranking system. More information about the ranking system can be found on the program web page at: <https://www.env.nm.gov/construction-programs/clean-water-state-revolving-fund-cwsrf/>. The program funds a wide range of wastewater and storm water projects. Funds may also be used for projects that control non-point source pollution, such as solid waste facilities. Placement on the annual priority list is the first step in obtaining CWSRF funding; applications are accepted year-round.

As of December 31, 2020, CPB had 35 active CWSRF loans with an undisbursed loan and grant balance of \$72.07 million dollars and one loan/grant accepted and in process of \$550,000. There were 64 loans in repayment with loan balances of over \$167.5 million dollars.

## HIGHLIGHTED PROJECT: CLEAN WATER STATE REVOLVING FUND

### Village of Los Lunas New Effluent Pipeline—CWSRF 060

In 2020, the Village of Los Lunas constructed a new parallel effluent pipeline with the purpose to increase capacity of the effluent discharge line from the existing wastewater treatment plant to accommodate future growth. A new 24-inch effluent pipeline 1,178 feet in length was installed approximately seven feet from the existing 16-inch effluent pipeline with an outfall structure approximately 15 feet from the existing pipe's outfall.

Based on the 2010 Census, the Village of Los Lunas is now the second-fastest-growing community in the State, just behind the City of Rio Rancho. Population growth between the 2000 Census and the 2010 Census was 47.8 percent. This extraordinary growth, and the corresponding increase in wastewater flows, has driven the need for expansion of the Village's wastewater infrastructure. The Village's existing NPDES Permit (NPDES No. NM0020303) allows the Village to discharge up to 2.7 million gallons per day (MGD). The existing 16-inch effluent line alone, however, did not have capacity to convey this flow rate.

Construction challenges included trench-cut installation of the 24-inch pipe across the Upper Belen Riverside Drain of the Middle of Rio Grande

Conservancy District (MRGCD) and environmental resources in the Rio Grande Bosque between the facility and the discharge point at the river where the pipeline was installed. A firm schedule constraint was placed on the construction sequence to cross the MRGCD drain in winter when the water level is lowest outside the irrigation season. With careful scheduling coordination between the contractor, engineer, MRGCD and Village, the MRGCD drain was successfully crossed.

Several wildlife species and birds use the bosque for habitat. Environmental surveys were conducted of the project area to evaluate biological and cultural resources present and to evaluate potential impacts from the project. In consultation with the resource protection agencies, construction activities were limited to non-nesting periods, tree removal was kept to a minimum of five, and for each tree removed five new live trees were replanted.

Construction of the effluent pipeline was substantially completed on September 8, 2020 with re-planting mature trees as the final work item. Funding Source: Clean Water State Revolving Loan Fund (CWSRF), \$582,600 and Village funds.

## HIGHLIGHTED PROJECT: CLEAN WATER STATE REVOLVING FUND

### El Valle de Los Ranchos Water and Sanitation District Wastewater Collection System Phases 4B-1 & 2D-1C CWSRF 075

#### Recipient of EPA's PISCES Award

The El Valle de Los Ranchos Water & Sanitation District (District) received a 2020 US EPA Performance and Innovation in the State Revolving Fund Creating Environmental Success (PISCES) Exceptional Project Award for "Excellence in Community Engagement." Of the 33 nominations from around the country, only five were selected by the EPA Office of Wastewater Management for recognition. The District was nominated by the NMED Construction Programs Bureau for their ongoing multi-phase wastewater collection system project that provides sewer service to multiple small communities, including Ranchos de Taos, Talpa, Llano Quemado, Cordillera, and Los Cordovas, thereby replacing sub-standard and failing septic systems and leach fields and protecting ground water. The wastewater from the District is treated at the Taos Valley Regional Wastewater Treatment and Reclamation Facility. The phased project has used a variety of other funding sources as well, including funding from the US Department of Agriculture and state legislative appropriations, and the District's ratepayers have also contributed significant funds.

The most recent phase, CWSRF 075, is 80% complete and is scheduled for completion in early 2021.

El Valle de Los Ranchos began planning their wastewater collection system in 1999 and completed their first Preliminary Engineering Report in 2001. The first construction project was started in 2004; since that time, the District has been progressing through the planned phases of the collection system. The District constructs collection lines as they obtain funding and they are connected to the Town of Taos wastewater treatment plant. The Taos WWTP was upgraded using CWSRF ARRA funds, adding capacity to allow the treatment of wastewater from the surrounding communities. Since 2004, the District has constructed over 27 miles of sewer lines with 865 residential and 36 commercial connections at a cost of approximately \$15 million. This has been accomplished with loan and grant funding obtained from a variety of sources, including CWSRF, USDA, legislative appropriations from the State of New Mexico, and the District's own funds. Beginning in 2012 the District has taken three loans from the CWSRF program totaling over \$4.5 million. It will complete 14,000 feet of collection lines and serve 165 connections.

# RURAL INFRASTRUCTURE PROGRAM: CPB LOAN PROGRAM

The Rural Infrastructure Program (RIP) provides financial assistance to mutual domestic water consumers associations, water and sanitation districts, municipalities with populations less than 20,000, and counties with populations less than 200,000. Funding is available for planning, design and construction of water, wastewater, and solid waste facilities. The interest rate is fixed at 2.375% with a repayment period of 20 years. The maximum loan amount is \$2,000,000 per entity per year. Funding through this program is on a first-come, first-served basis and is contingent on the fund balance at the time of application. This program has a fast turnaround time for funding.

As of December 31, 2020 CPB had 14 active RIP loans, with an undisbursed loan and grant balance of \$3.09 million dollars and 74 loans in repayment with a loan balance of \$19.4 million.

## HIGHLIGHTED PROJECT: RURAL INFRASTRUCTURE PROGRAM

### Doña Ana MDWCA Wastewater Treatment Facility Upgrade Project

Doña Ana Mutual Domestic Water Consumers Association (DAMDWCA) was established in 1976 with 76 connections supplied by a single well. They have since grown and presently serve almost 6,000 water connections and 1,500 wastewater connections serving over 15,000 people. They are the largest Mutual Domestic in the State of New Mexico. In December 2013 the Association acquired Picacho Hills Utility Company which served roughly 900 homes with water and 850 homes with wastewater service.

The purchase of the Picacho Hills Utility Company was accomplished with the assistance of the Rural Infrastructure Loan Fund and after over six years of work the wastewater treatment plant has been upgraded to an activated sludge treatment process with effluent discharge to evaporative ponds and the Picacho Hills Golf Course. The new facility is designed to be large enough to handle full build out of the Picacho Hills Subdivision. The funding provided by the Rural Infrastructure Program totals \$8.75 million dollars.


## CAPITAL OUTLAY PROGRAM (CO) DETAILS

Capital Outlay (CO) consists of state grants for in-frastructure projects that are appropriated by the New Mexico Legislature and approved by the Governor. Funds are distributed through assigned state agencies that provide administrative and technical oversight. Projects pertaining to water, wastewater, solid waste, or other environmental infrastructure are routinely assigned to the Environment Department Construction Programs Bureau. CPB provides administrative support in accordance with DFA Capital Outlay Bureau guidelines and provides technical support to the grantees. In the 2020 legislative session, CPB received 143 new CO projects valued at \$50,607,477 funded by the General Fund (GF) and Severance Tax Bonds (STB).

There were 14 reauthorized CO projects valued at \$2,814,561.83 funded by both General Fund and Severance Tax Bonds (STB). As of December 31, 2020 CPB was performing administration and technical oversight for 286 CO projects. From January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020 CPB closed 70 projects valued at \$9,964,456.03 executed 101 projects valued at \$34,228,696 and disbursed \$16,327,459.73 in combined STB and GF funds.



## HIGHLIGHTED PROJECT: CAPITAL OUTLAY PROGRAM (CO)

### **City of Artesia – New Tank, Booster Pump Station and Chlorination System**

In 2020, the City of Artesia constructed a new 500,000-gallon water storage tank with booster pump station and chlorination system housed in a 950 square foot building. The project was constructed to address flow and low-pressure zones. A chlorination system was added to address boil water notices issued in 2017.

Prior to commencing design, the City asked their engineer to research the City's storage and pressure needs for the City's water distribution system. A water storage report was completed that identified the need for 0.5 million gallons additional storage and increased pressure in the area of the airport. From the study, the City learned that due to proximity to the airport the height of the tank would be limited, and a booster pump station was required to meet pressure needs. With the distribution system needs clearly identified in the study, the design was completed in six months. The chlorination system was added to the contract as a change order. The contract time was extended due to delays associated with the pandemic.

NMED CPB approved the engineering agreement May 27, 2017, the water storage report in December 14, 2017, and the plans and specifications prepared by Smith Engineering Company for the new tank and booster station project on June 6, 2019. Bids were opened on July 31, 2019. The low bidder was Smithco Construction, Inc. with a bid of \$1,878,000 exclusive of tax. The City of Artesia approved the construction contract and provided the notice to proceed (NTP) with construction to Smithco Construction, Inc. on January 6, 2020. The project is in the process of being closed out. Funding Sources: Capital Outlay Special Appropriations (SAP) SAP 16-A2260 (\$360,000), SAP 18-C2248-STB (\$100,000), SAP 19-D2460 (\$350,000) and City funds.


### San Juan County-Apple Orchard (formerly Harvest Gold) Water System Improvements Project

In 2016 the NMED Drinking Water Bureau issued a boil water advisory to what was then the Harvest Gold Water System. Harvest Gold was a privately-owned water system and therefore ineligible for public money. The old Harvest Gold water system facilities included a raw water storage pond, water treatment plant (WTP), two water storage tanks, water distribution system piping varying in size and appurtenances. The water treatment plant was taken offline due to its inability to provide adequate treatment. High turbidity in the finished water was one of the reasons NMED issued the boil water advisory.

Apple Orchard is a community-owned water utility that formed during the boil water advisory as a way of getting public funding to repair and upgrade the former Harvest Gold water system. After the treatment plant was taken offline, Apple Orchard received drinking water from the City of Bloomfield (City) as part of an emergency project. The City of Bloomfield installed a booster pump station located on County Road 7903 on the south side of Citizens Ditch. This booster pump station currently supplies water to the new Apple Orchard water system.

San Juan County received capital outlay funding in 2017 in the amount of three million dollars for the construction of regional water systems. Part of this funding was used to construct improvements to the Apple Orchard Water System. The improvements included the construction of 11,500 feet of 6-inch waterline, 1,200 feet of 8-inch waterline, gate valves, 20 fire hydrants, 140 new water services with automatic read meters and a new 150,000-gallon storage tank. The two old storage tanks and the old Harvest Gold WWTP were demolished. The total cost of the project was \$1,797,000.00. Apple Orchard took over ownership and operations in May 2020.

## **City of Grants Pond J – Effluent Storage Pond**

The City of Grants constructed new wastewater treatment facilities in 2019 using \$16.5 million dollars of Clean Water State Revolving Loan Fund (CWSRF). The plant discharges to a series of ponds located at the Coyote Del Malpais Golf Course. The high-quality effluent is used to water the golf course offsetting the need for potable water. After the completion of the new facilities the City needed to make improvements to address conditions of Discharge Permit 695 (DP-695) issued by the New Mexico Environment (NMED) Department Ground Water Quality Bureau. Condition #25 of the permit required a contingency plan in the event that the effluent from the new wastewater treatment plant did not meet Class 1B standards for fecal coliform, Biological Oxygen Demand (BOD5) or Total Suspended Solids (TSS). The contingency plan is to divert via gravity non-compliant effluent to Pond J at the golf course. Pond J will be synthetically lined with a high-density polyethylene (HDPE) liner to eliminate any potential seepage into groundwater. Pond J will be completely isolated from the effluent reuse golf course storage pond system.

The proposed improvements included: clearing and grubbing of the existing pond J, excavation of native material and testing to ensure existing material was suitable for a liner, and installation of the HDPE liner. The project also included construction of a new pump station and 6-inch force main that will pump stored effluent back to the headworks of the new treatment facility for treatment, and new security fencing to keep public from entering Pond J.

NMED CPB approved the plans and specifications for the Pond J Liner Improvements project on February 27, 2020 and bids were opened on April 23, 2020. The low bidder was Smithco Construction, Inc. with a bid of \$602,172. The City of Grants approved the construction contract and provided the notice to proceed (NTP) with construction to Smithco on Jun 15, 2020. Construction of Pond J was substantially completed on November 9, 2020, and acceptance by City was on December 8, 2020.
