



Intellus New Mexico is a publicly-accessible database containing environmental monitoring data provided by the Los Alamos National Laboratory (LANL), the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) DOE Oversight Bureau (DOE OB), and other third-party providers (such as local and Tribal entities).

- Contains over 16 million records from more than 32,000 locations and 400,000 samples
- Includes both recent and historical data (1942-present)
- Find data with a quick search or advanced query
- Generate charts to easily see trends in analytical data
- Map sampling areas and results with GIS tools
