RE: Emergency Powers Order 2016-3 Notice of Non-Compliance

Mr. Whistle:

In response to the ongoing boil water advisory that was issued on June 3, 2016 and ongoing noncompliance with several significant deficiencies at the Harvest Gold Subdivision (System No. NM3511524), the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) issued Emergency Order (EO) 2016-3 on September 23, 2016. This EO requires the Harvest Gold Subdivision to take specific actions to address the ongoing water emergencies at the water system.

The NMED's Drinking Water Bureau (DWB) has evaluated Harvest Gold Subdivision's compliance with the requirements of EO 2016-3 as of November 4, 2016 and is providing you with the attached Notice of Non-Compliance.

As of November 4, 2016 the Harvest Gold Subdivision has accumulated the following fines:
