## THE AIR QUALITY BUREAU OF THE NEW MEXICO ENVIRONMENT DEPARTMENT'S ANSWER TO THE PETITION FOR HEARING

In the Applicant's petition for hearing on the Indian Basin Gas Plant's Title V operating permit, it objects to three permit conditions: A107.C, A206.C and A206.D. Although the nature of the objections are not stated in narrative form, the Applicant submitted re-writes of the relevant portions using Microsoft Word's track changes feature.

Because the entirety of A206.C and A206.D appear to have been re-written, the specific nature of those objections is unclear and the Bureau cannot provide a response. Nonetheless, Bureau personnel report that post-submission negotiations are going well.

Condition A107.C focuses on a rolling timetable. Measuring it in "days" rather than "months" provides the Bureau with more precise information when estimating emissions, thus allowing for better regulation and, if necessary, enforcement.

While this Answer has been filed to comply with procedural guidelines, the Bureau reiterates that negotiations are progressing and a stay of proceedings will likely result in private resolution.
