**ENTERPRISE PRODUCTS OPERATING LLC'S UNOPPOSED MOTION
REQUESTING WAIVER OF 90 DAY DEADLINE FOR HEARING**


Comes now Respondent, Enterprise Products Operating, LLC (“Enterprise”), and pursuant to Rule 20.1.3.19(B)(1) of the Water Quality Control Commission (“WQCC”), hereby requests a waiver of the 90-day deadline for the hearing officer to hold a hearing in this matter.

In support of this Motion, Enterprise states as follows:

1. WQCC Rule 20.1.3.19(B)(1) requires a compliance order hearing to “be scheduled to begin no later than 90 days after the date a request for compliance order hearing is received, unless a stipulated or unopposed motion is filed requesting that the 90 day deadline be waived.”
2. Enterprise filed its Answer and Request for Hearing on May 15, 2015.
3. Enterprise requests a waiver of the 90 day deadline for the compliance order hearing because tasks necessary to prepare for the hearing are expected to take longer than three months. Counsel will work with the hearing officer to develop a scheduling order establishing deadlines for this case, including a hearing date in mid- to late September, 2015, if appropriate.
4. Counsel for the Oil Conservation Division does not oppose this Motion.


