

SCHEDULING ORDER

On May 12, 2016, the Chair of the Water Quality Control Commission (“Commission”) designated Jeffrey N. Holappa, Administrative Law Judge for the New Mexico Environment Department, to schedule the public hearing before the Commission and serve as Hearing Officer pursuant to Section 104 of the Guidelines for Water Quality Control Commission Regulation Hearings (“Guidelines”). Accordingly, the Hearing Officer issues the following Scheduling Order.

The public hearing will be held during the Commission’s scheduled meeting on **Tuesday, August 9, 2016 at 9:00 a.m.** in Room 307 of the State Capitol Building, 490 Old Santa Fe Trail, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87501. The Surface Water Quality Bureau **SHALL** prepare and issue public notice of the public hearing in accordance with Section 302 of the Guidelines. The public hearing will be conducted in accordance with the Water Quality Act, NMSA 1978, Section 74-6-5, the Guidelines, and all other applicable law.
